
#### **CHANDRAHAS CHOUDHURY**

- Our mentors will conduct workshops and masterclasses specifically designed to develop your writing style and niche, hone your craft and techniques, help you experiment with new creative tools, and decode the publishing process in India.
- Writers can revise their work in real time based on the mentors' advice and feedback received from peers.

# THE VENUE

Island House

Island house is set on the island of Divar and embodies Goa's 'slow-living' and 'suggard' philosophy.

Island House is a century old Portuguese villa that captures the history and character of this island.



Located along the Mandovi River only 10.6 km from Panjim, it is one of six major islands within the Mandovi.

Get transported to a different world with serene villages, tree-lined streets, lush greenery, old Portuguese architecture, and the chirps of birds.
