

THE VENUE



Wallwood Garden – A 19th century quaint Scottish-style mansion

Wallwood was built by a Scottish Major General from the village of Blair Athol in Scotland.

It became a boarding house after the First World War and was purchased by Liptons before the Second World War due to its proximity to sprawling tea plantations. Since then, it has remained with tea companies, and is currently with Matheson Bosanquet.
